Fares

TAGS – Fairfax Connector Route 350

The fare for **Route 350** between the Franconia-Springfield Metro & VRE Station and Metro Park is **FREE**.

The fare for **Route 350** between the Franconia-Springfield Metro & VRE Station and Springfield Town Center and Hilton Springfield is **\$0.50**, SmarTrip® or Cash.

The fare for **Route 350 Midday service** between the Franconia-Springfield Metro & VRE Station and the TSA headquarters, the NVCC Medical Education Campus, and Springfield Town Center is **FREE**.

TAGS – Fairfax Connector Route 351

The fare for **Route 351** between the Franconia-Springfield Metro & VRE Station and the TSA headquarters and the NVCC Medical Education Campus is **FREE**.

VRE Transfers

Passengers transferring from the VRE system to a Fairfax Connector bus will be allowed a free, one-way transfer when boarding at a VRE station. Passengers must display valid VRE fare media (passes, tickets).

Passengers returning on a Fairfax Connector bus to a VRE station are required to pay the full, applicable bus fare.
